Senior Warden's report—The nominees for 2019 Vestry Class are Robert Joines, Carrie Mash, René Garces, and Cheryl Waechter.

Junior Warden's report—The willow oak needs some care; we will be spending money on it to keep it healthy for the next decade or so. CPR and first aid training will be in January; there are still a couple of spots available for those interested. Dishwasher installation is scheduled for this month. A message from St. Paul's in Smithfield says there is much work to be done in Eastern North Carolina for hurricane recovery. Volunteers are welcome.

Financial report—The preliminary October report is not done because we were having problems with WeShare and thus could not register regular givers. The problem should be solved tomorrow. We are still in good shape and overall up for the year. The only over-budget department is education, both adult and youth. The water bill is large, mostly due to fees the city imposes.

Lori asked about the status of the Memorial Garden; to whom do they report? Stephanie said for money, the Vestry, otherwise, Buildings and Grounds. Stephanie said Jennie should have all the background information about how many burials, where, etc. Lori wondered about how people interested in a plot get information; Stephanie said they would talk.

Stewardship—We have 55 pledges so far, totaling about \$145,000. This does not count what came in Sunday. That will be tallied tomorrow.


